



## Nebraska School Break Emergency Food Options

*While schools are closed, these food resources are available*

Economic challenges continue to affect tens of thousands of Nebraskans. Please make use of these food resources if you or your family need them.

### Emergency Food Distributions and Pantries

*Across the State:*

- Call 2-1-1 or text your zip code to 898-211 to find a list of local food distributions and their hours of operation. 2-1-1's resource database can also be found online at [search.ne211.org/](http://search.ne211.org/).

*Lincoln and Southeast Nebraska:*

*Omaha, Northeast, Central, and Western Nebraska:*

### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
