## **2023 HIGHLIGHTS**

### **Economic Justice**

 Launched the Paid Sick Leave for Nebraska campaign to secure paid sick leave for all workers on the November 2024 ballot.

 Secured a Nebraska Supreme Court concurring opinion casting constitutional doubt on Nebraska's law denying renters a right to a jury trial in eviction proceedings.

 Extended eligibility increases for food assistance and child care subsidies, maintaining benefits for thousands of Nebraskans.

 Organized our first two Food Access Community Advocates Cohorts, supporting community members with lived experience in storytelling and advocacy.

 Launched with partners the Coalition for Source of Income Protections for Lincoln renters and submitted over 500 petition signatures to the City Council.

 Secured Summer EBT to provide food assistance for 150,000+ kids facing hunger during the summer after collecting 6,500+ signatures from 230 communities pressuring the Governor to adopt the program.



### **Health Care Access**

 Passed legislation expanding Medicaid postpartum coverage from 60 days to 12 months, ensuring mothers can access the critical health care they need.


• Launched our first **Health Care Advocacy Leadership Cohort**.

 Advocated to prevent mass health insurance coverage losses and unnecessary terminations during the unwinding of Medicaid continuous coverage protections.

 Joined the Protect Our Rights campaign to enact a constitutional amendment to protect abortion access.

## Legislative Advocacy

- Supported or opposed 63 pieces of legislation, our largest state legislative agenda.
- Federal advocacy on child welfare policy, positive federal immigration policy, and protecting SNAP in the Farm Bill.

Retirement Account or Life Insurance: You can designate Appleseed as a full, partial, or contingent beneficiary of your retirement account (such as an IRA) or a life insurance policy that has outlived its purpose. Contact your plan administrator or life insurance company for a beneficiary designation form.

**Donor-Advised Fund (DAF):** If you maintain a DAF, you can designate Appleseed to receive the remainder or a share of your account's value.
